


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?



For the overall development of the institution and betterment of college curriculum the students have suggested that Latest technology, infrastructure and Library should be upgraded. They have also suggested to use projector in classrooms and smart classrooms should also be enhanced. They have also pointed out about regular inspection from the higher authorities to have the check on the quality of the education and students meeting should be arranged after every 3 months to gather the information about the college. Class Seminars should also be conducted in every week and this will help the students and teachers more interactive and corporative. Extracurricular activities should be organized at large scale.

Regarding the coverage of syllabus, 26.2% of students satisfied with the coverage of syllabus from 55% to 69%. About the teachers preparation of the class, communication skills and approach the students have observed 57.1%, 54.8% and 36.9% respectively. About the fairness of Internal Evaluation 57.1% of students observed as always fair. 38% of the students said that discussion of assignments performance with them. Regarding the internship promoted by the institution 36.9% of the students have observed regularly and about the multiple opportunities to learn and grow 52.4% students are fully agree. Regarding identifying student's strength & weaknesses and encouragement 45.2% of the students are fully agreed. 50% of the students are strongly agreed in context with encouraging the students to participate in extra-curricular activities. About the % of teachers using ICT tools 50% of the students have observed 90%. About the overall teaching learning process 19% of the students have observed 50 to 69%.

Overall the students are satisfied with the performance of the institution.
