About the Survey



- c) The responses given by the students for the questionnaire provided to the students are given below.







4. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by teacher?







For the overall development of the institution and betterment of college curriculum the students have suggested that C.C. TV Cameras may kindly be installed to have a check on all the activities in the campus. Reading room of the Library should be enlarged with sufficient seating arrangements. Internet facilities should be provided to all the stakeholders and they have also suggested to use Interactive digital whiteboard in smart classrooms for online teaching. They have also pointed out about regular inspection from the higher authorities to have the check on the quality of the education and students meeting should be arranged after every 3 months to gather the information about the college. Class Seminars should also be conducted in every week and this will help the students and teachers more interactive and corporative. Extracurricular activities should be organized at large scale.

- The analysis of the survey conducted shows that, 67.7% of the students are of the opinion that the coverage of syllabus is more than 70%.
- About the teachers preparation of the class, communication skills and approach, 85.3% and 70.6% respectively, students have shown satisfaction with the remarks very good.
- About the fairness of Internal Evaluation, 64.7% of students observed as always fair.
- 58.8% of the teachers every time discuss assignments performance with students.
 73.6% of the students have shown satisfaction in promoting internship, field visit and monitoring process by the institution,
- 76.4 % of students strongly agree regarding multiple opportunities provided by the institute for student's growth and learning
- Regarding identifying student's strength & weaknesses and encouragement, 52.9% of the students are fully agreed.
- 79.4% of the students are strongly agreed in context with encouraging the students to participate in extra-curricular activities.
- Regarding the use of ICT tools by teachers, more than 50% of the students have shown satisfaction that 70% of the teachers are using ICT tools.
